- V. Commissioner report
 - Created a schedule for sports for the league based on the CCS revised calendar of sports seasons
 - This will be a very difficult schedule to execute and there are a lot of details
PP: referred to now as season 1 and season 2--season 2 is blend of winter and spring
JC: because of the new seasons, no workouts, conditioning while there is no school.
What is the transition back to conditioning
BK: depends on the county health direction
PP: coaches can still communicate with their teams, just not in person
BK: Consideration for principals--can't go outside the county to play sports. Really impacts the schools and league. December 14 seems like an early start date.
PP: will be challenging to meet the full schedule of games with facilities, practice schedules, etc.
ER: Students need to have more flexibility to play more than one sport; need to emphasize to coaches that students need to be able to do that.
 - A lot of the decisions made were based on transportation, which is not the same issue for
 - State guidelines are firm; football season can start later if we like. Football is the only full season on the CCS guidelines.

- Sites determine eligibility guidelines

BK: ADs and SCCAL will need some direction on the scheduling of athletics, including league tournaments. There are a lot of details to figure out

JC: Can you tell us what you would like from the BOM

BK: What is the most important things you want? League tournament, all games?

ER: We are concerned with how to make an A, B, or C option for football. We don't have answers about whether we are playing in the county only. What if we play within the county and then we can't leave the county.

Do we have a plan to make a league within those? We need to decide--do we want to have a league tournament and leave it at that? Do we create a schedule and then cancel?

ER: Riddel, with COVID they won't be able to recondition the equipment in time for the fall 2021 season

More information is needed about the equipment reconditioning possibility--PP contacted CCS and they will look into the reality of this information.

JC: If the county says we can only play in the county we are out

NA: Can we make a temporary league to play in the county?

ER: If we can't leave the county, then we might be able to do that

PP: Seems like a plan B because we are in the PCAL as plan A

JC: Would create a non-equity league within the county

BK: Last part of football season is cost--additional or reduced due to COVID

ER: Reemphasized the need to be flexible with students and multiple sport athletes--especially in season 2. Coaches need to be understanding and allow students to miss practice, etc. and still play.
